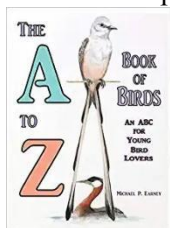
## SPECIAL PROGRAMS:



**January 12<sup>th</sup> at 6 p.m. Cashflow 101 Part One** with Naman Garg for financial control, budgeting and wealth building.

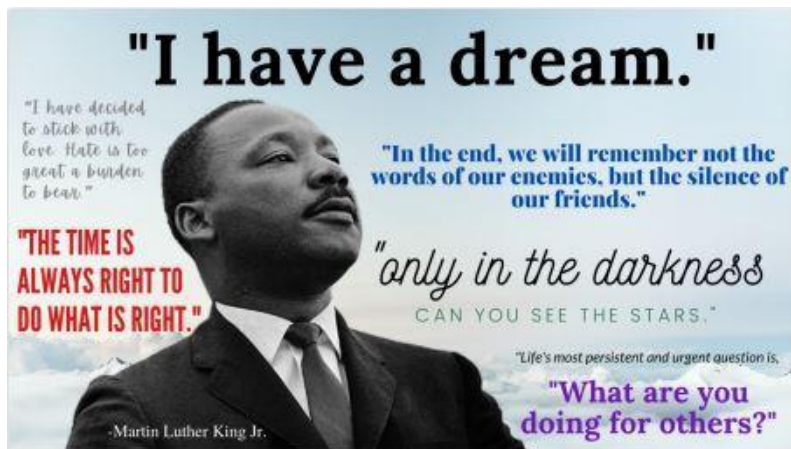
