Homer Delgado currently serves as the Chief of Police for the City of Dilley, Texas. In his tenure there, he has done an excellent job of building strong, transparent relationships between the citizens of Dilley and the police department. He has served the City of Ingleside, San Patricio County Sheriff's Office, Medina County Attorney's Office, and City of Terrell Hills.

Chief Delgado's history of relationship building was witnessed here in Uvalde when he served as Incident Commander for Operation Coyote Overwatch in May 2022.
