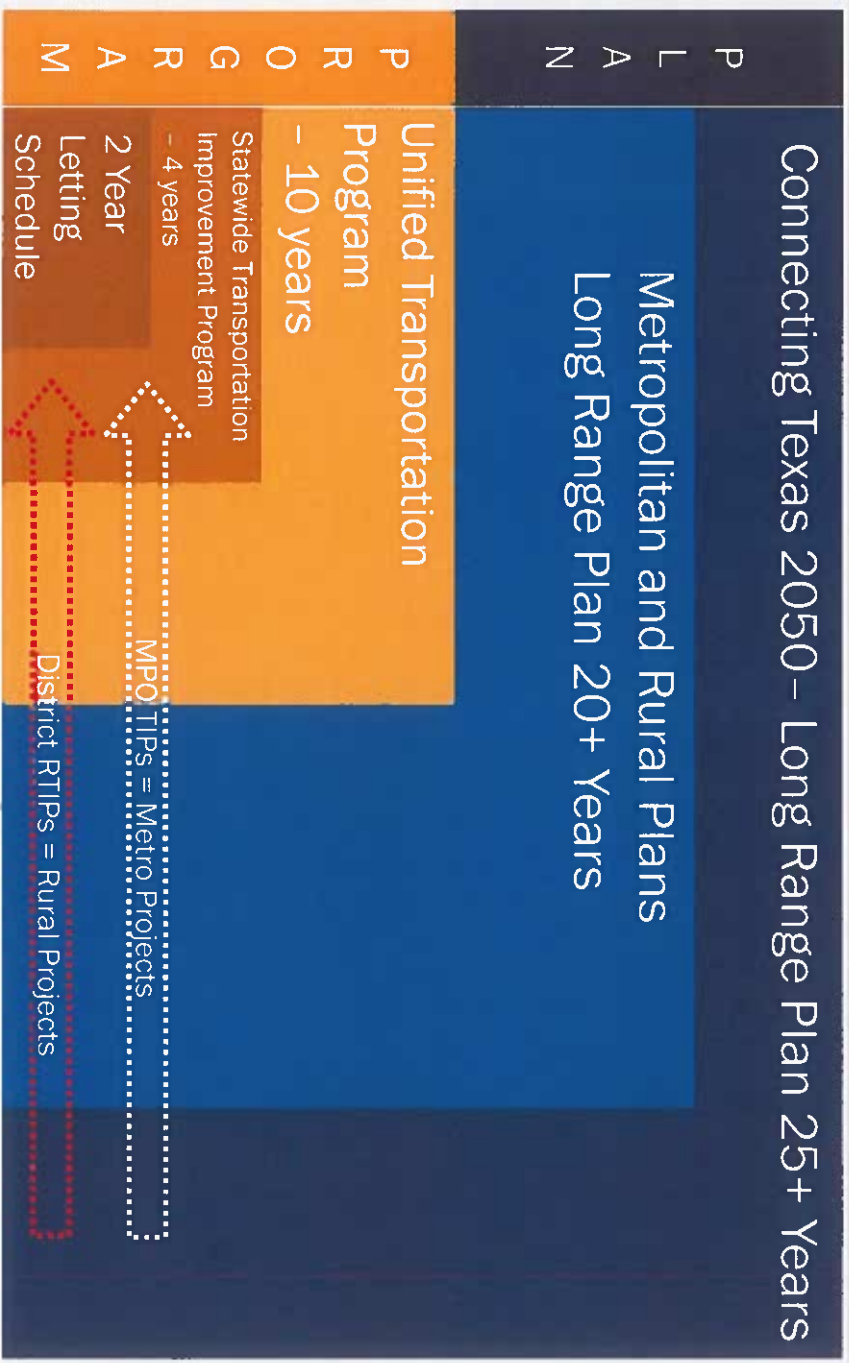

It can include projects for :

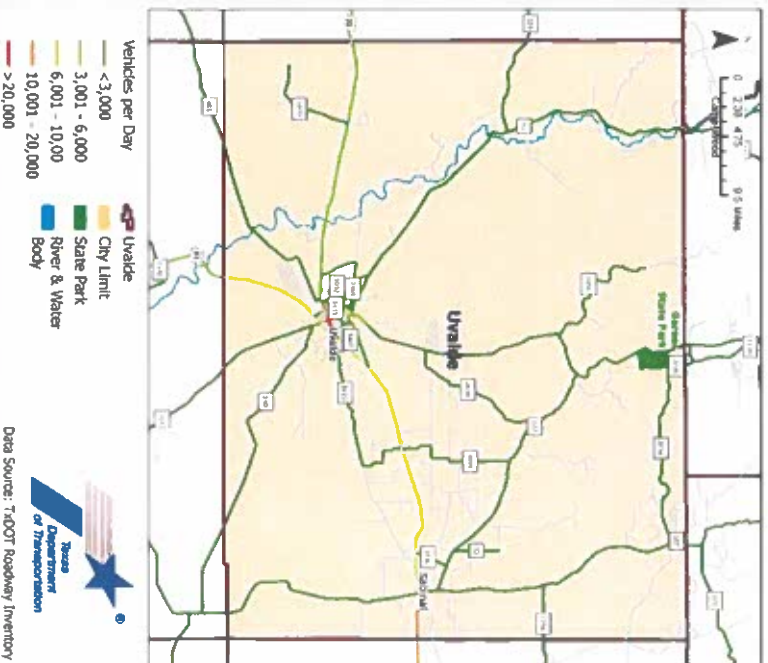


A Rural TIP project is anticipated to be funded within the next 4 years.

Uvalde County Average Daily Traffic

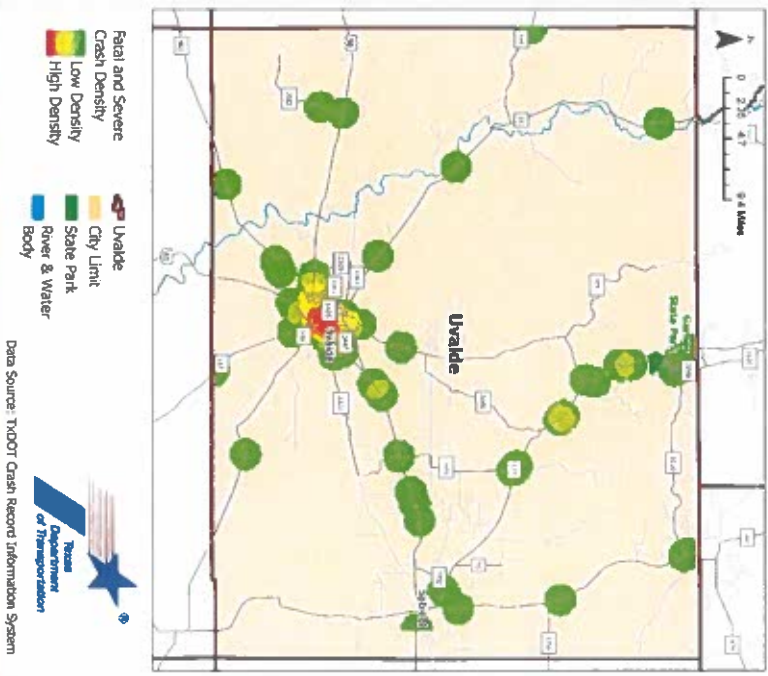
Average Daily Traffic

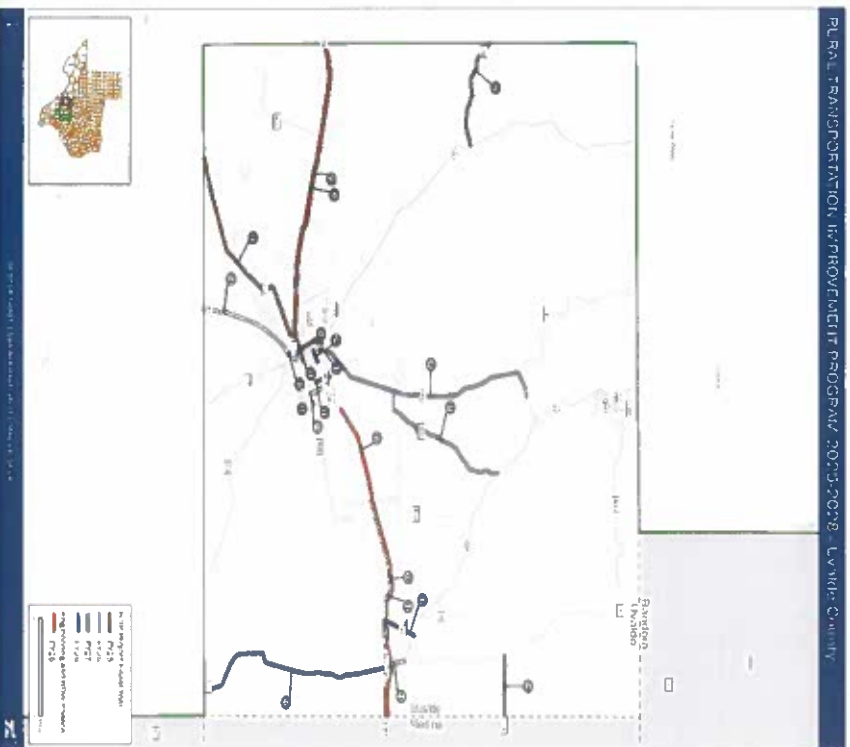
