1. Canvass results of the November 5th, 2024 election:

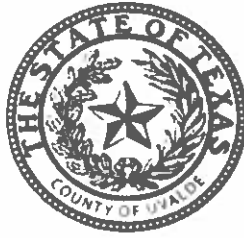
The Uvalde County Elections Administrator, Melissa Jones, presented the election results for the 11/5/2024 General Election, and the corresponding Precinct Returns.

The Uvalde Consolidated Independent School District applied for an Environmental Protection Agency grant in the amount of \$20 million. If awarded, the grant would allow the school district to make needed facility improvements. The County would be a sub-recipient and could receive approximately \$1.5 million which could be utilized to provide counseling services at the Uvalde Together Resiliency Center.

6. Consider and act upon swearing-in of Justice of the Peace, Pct. 6 to fill unexpired term:

Roland Sanchez won the Justice of the Peace Pct. 6 election. The regular term starts on January 1, 2025. The position is currently vacant. Sanchez will be sworn in for the newly elected term in January 2025.

RESOLUTION

Resolution of Support for County Motor Fuel Tax Exemption

WHEREAS, Texas Counties are the action arm of the state government and are responsible for the operation and management of many various state governmental programs as required or authorized by state law; and

WHEREAS, Texas Counties provide essential state services to constituents at the local level which are fully or partially supported with funds disbursed by the State of Texas pursuant to the state appropriations process; and

WHEREAS, Texas Counties provide emergency management services to the citizens of the State of Texas, and serve as first responders during disasters to clear roads and provide lifesaving rescue and recovery support to local, regional, state, and federal agencies; and

WHEREAS, the rising cost fuel costs have a significant impact on county budgets; and

WHEREAS, the State of Texas has authorized a motor fuel tax exemption for Volunteer Fire Departments which partner with Texas Counties to provide lifesaving fire response and mitigation to citizens of Texas; and

WHEREAS, the State of Texas has authorized a motor fuel tax exemption to Texas Public Schools for motor fuel taxes which helps reduce expenses to local school districts and alleviate the impact of local school property taxes to the citizens of Texas; and

WHEREAS, exempting Texas motor fuel taxes for Texas Counties will reduce tax churn in the state and further alleviate the impact of local county property taxes to the citizens of Texas.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Uvalde County Commissioners Court does hereby resolve that for the foregoing reasons, it is in the best interest of Texas counties and their taxpayers to support and favor passage of legislation that exempts counties from certain motor fuels taxes.

RIVER CLEANUP CONTRACTOR

Update

The River Contractors finished strong with a great year of cleaning.

The crew worked 22 weeks this year and picked up over 7 thousand pounds of trash.

This does not include the three 30-yard roll-off dumpsters that were placed for the week before and after July 4th. Each of these roll-offs were at least half full, if not almost completely full. On average, each roll-off contained about 5,000 pounds of trash.

This brings the total to over 20,000 pounds of trash for the 2024 season.

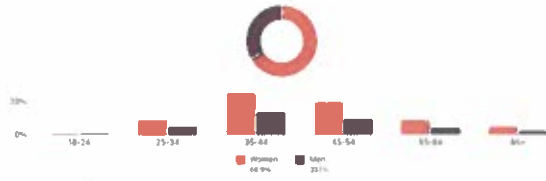

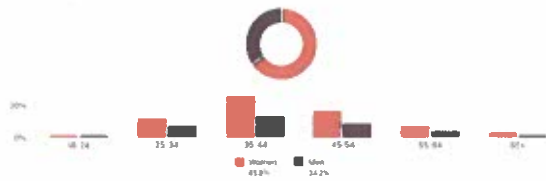

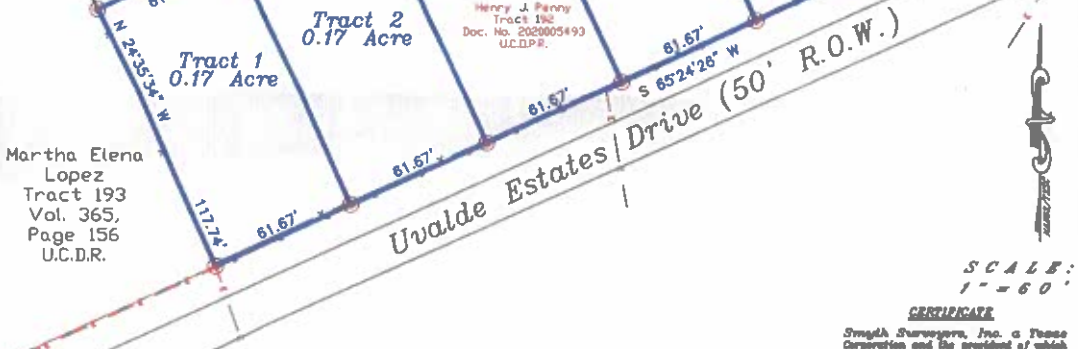
